To whom it may concern,

This letter is in response to concerns regarding EU directives on the restrictions of the use of certain hazardous Substances, (RoHS), Directive (EU) 2015/863, and 2002/96/EC, Waste from Electrical and Electronic Equipment, (WEEE) which addresses the possible presence of hazardous materials in our production. None of these substances are intentionally or knowingly used in the manufacturing of OSG USA, Inc's products. We have no reason to believe that any of these substances are created by our manufacturing process. As a result, we do not expect these substances to be detectable in our product and therefore we do not specify or test for a maximum level of any of these substances.
